

W. P. Carey Q2 Fact Sheet 2018

W. P. Carey ranks among the largest diversified net lease REITs with an enterprise value of over \$11 billion and an internally-managed portfolio of operationally-critical commercial real estate, totaling 878 properties covering approximately 87 million square feet as of June 30, 2018. For over four decades we have invested in high-quality single-tenant industrial, warehouse, office and retail properties subject to long-term leases with built-in rent escalators. Our portfolio is located primarily in North America and Northern and Western Europe and is well-diversified by tenant, property type, geographic location and tenant industry.

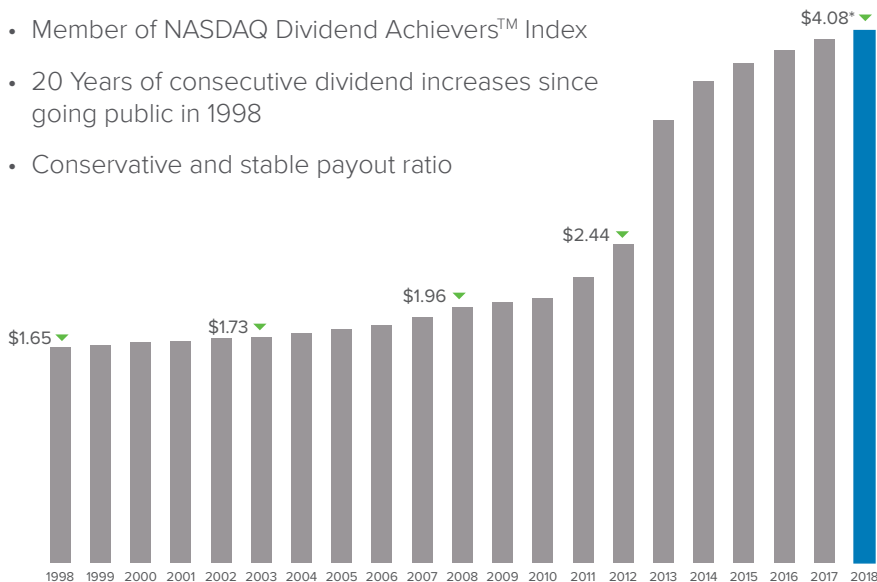

- Conservative and stable payout ratio

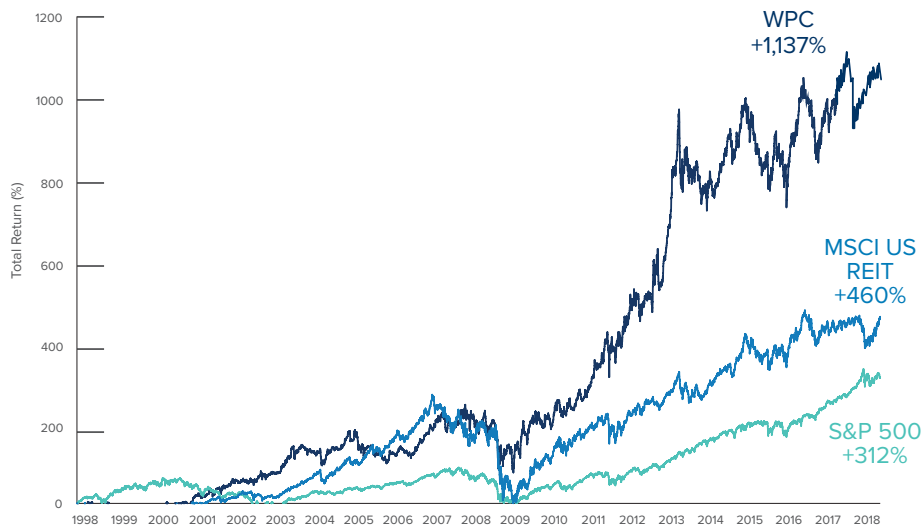


Full-year dividend per share reflects sum of quarterly dividends per share for the respective year. Chart is not reflective of special dividends paid in 2007, 2009 and 2013.

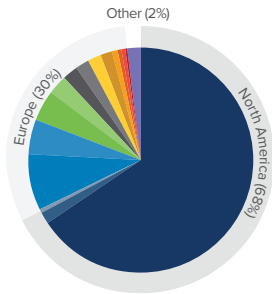

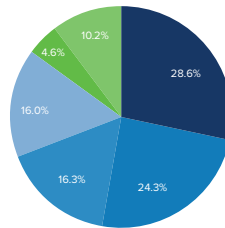

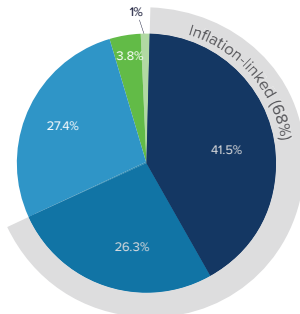
